

# Kilmer Shrines

This walking tour takes the form of a pilgrimage to a network of shrines dedicated to the local drainage system. You will be offered a chance to investigate the overlay of geography, history, technology and ecology onto present day land use and to try out an alternate way of relating to your immediate surroundings. In addition, the tour will include hidden remnants of university infrastructure, the former site of the Mason Gross sculpture department, and landmarks of Camp Kilmer, a World War II military base.

Full-length tours are at least two hours long and depart from the Livingston Arts Building of Rutgers University (39 Road Three). 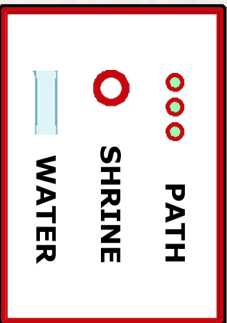
